3. HAZARD IDENTIFICATION

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Avoid breathing dust. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product has low solubility in water. At the limit of solubility, this product is not toxic to fish. 4. FIRST AID

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Clean up spills immediately observing the precautions in Section 8 of this MSDS. Control spill at the source and prevent material from entering soil, sewers, waterways or low areas. Scrub area with hard water detergent (e.g., Tide, Joy, Spic and Span, etc.) and pick up wash liquid with additional absorbent and place into compatible disposal containers.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE
