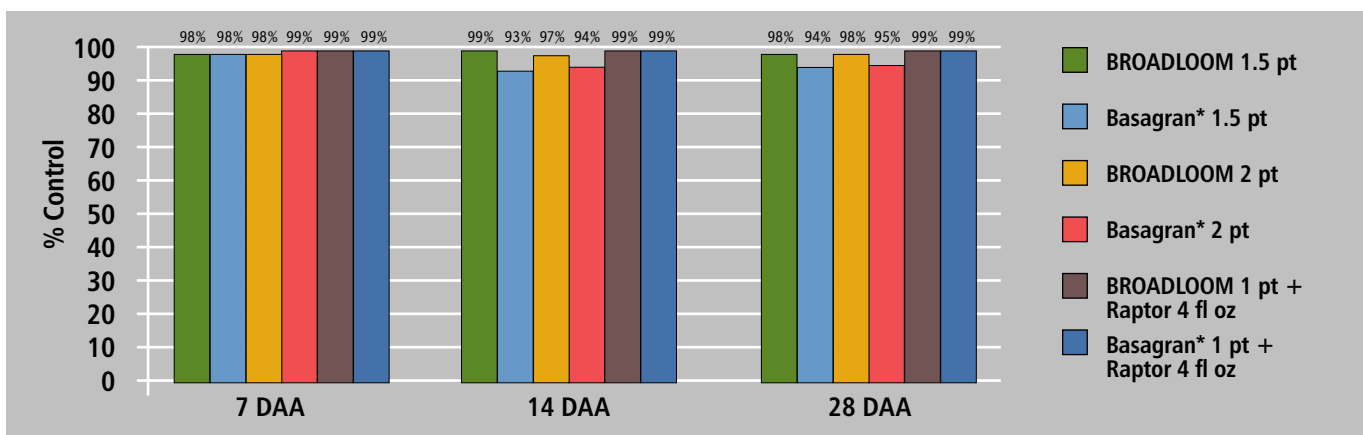

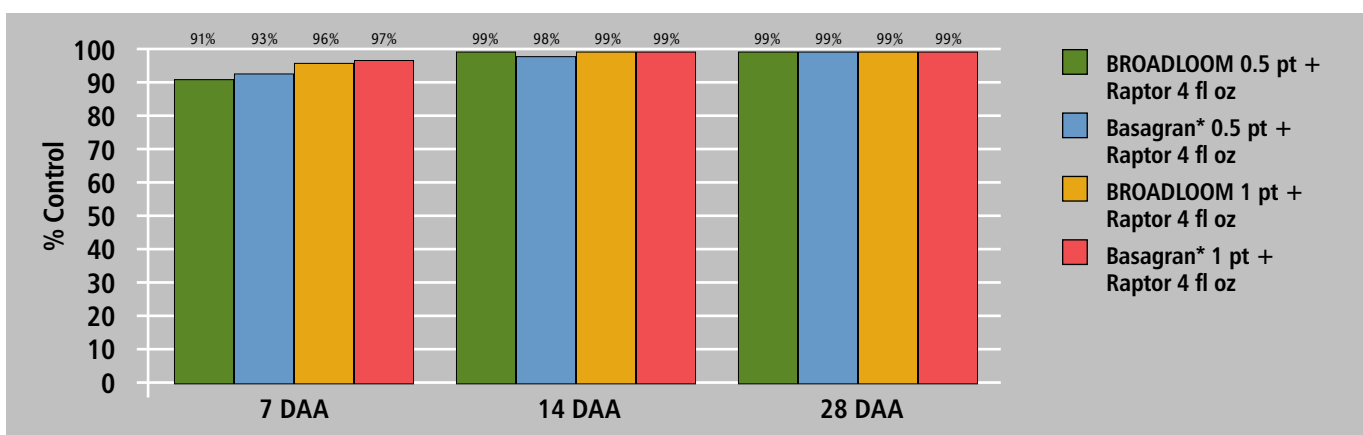


BROADLOOM vs. BASAGRAN* IN DRY BEANS - % Control (Velvetleaf)
